












Roosevelt couple celebrates 72nd wedding anniversary

He finally caught the hat and jumped on it, that's when Nate noticed Lorraine (who was 14 at the time) standing by a tree giggling at him.

Family members say Lorraine lied to Nate about how old she was. He asked if she was 16 and she just let him believe that. A year later, on June 19, 1944, the Fillingim's were married in Elko, Nevada.

Lorraine still giggles thinking about Nate stomping on his hat.

While they couldn't think of any great marriage advice to give, their children said they gave each of them advice before their weddings.


"When my husband and I got married, my father said 'you can come to me for any advice you want, but it's your problem, you go home and take care of it," their daughter Barbara Ross said.
